The members of the EMT are the Managing Director and the five functional General Managers.

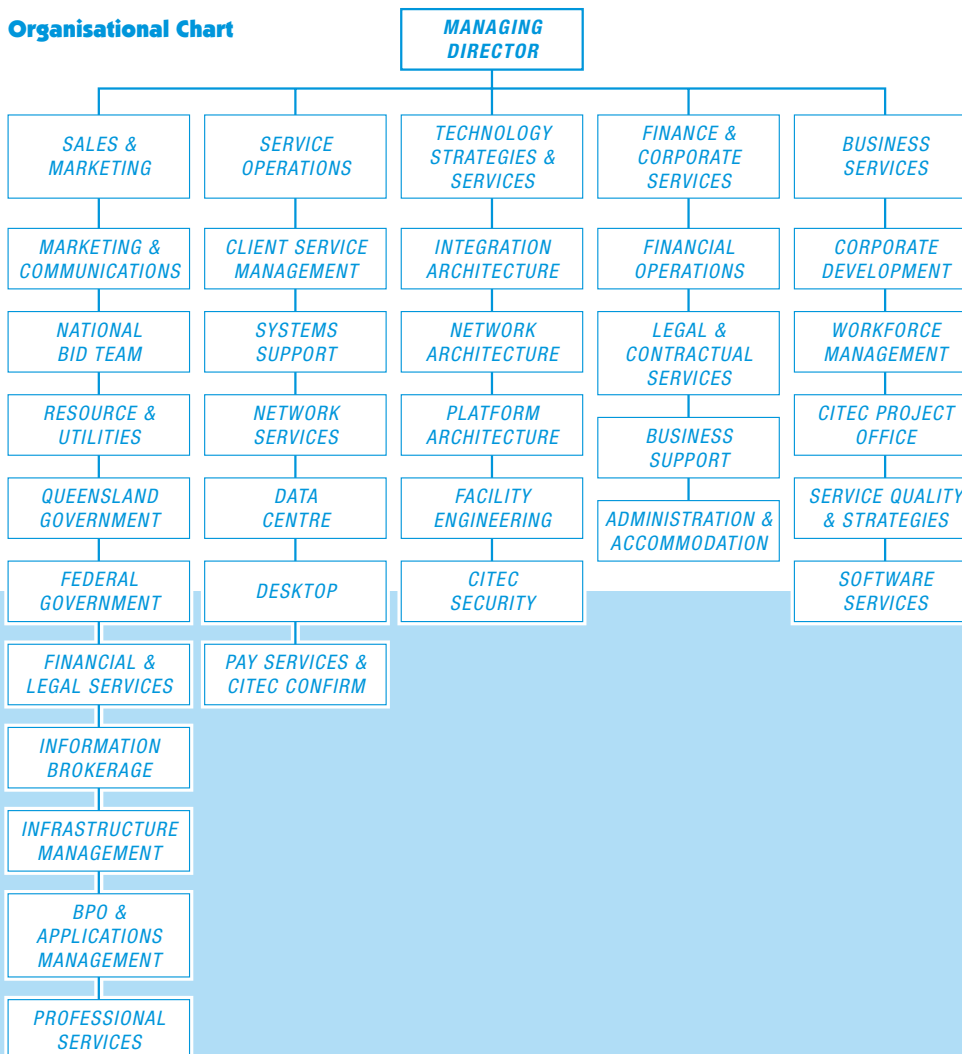
